WHAT IS KIMEP UNIVERSITY?

WHAT IS A GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF ALMATY?

The city of Almaty is situated at the base of majestic Tien Shan Mountains in Southeast Kazakhstan. About 1.7 million people live in or near Almaty because it is the financial, cultural, summer and winter sports and cosmopolitan capital of Kazakhstan. Kazakhstan is located in the heart of Eurasia with important commercial inroads bridging Asia and Europe. Boasting the Silk Road of the 21st century, Kazakhstan offers unique positions in oil and gas, economic development, and trade. With a transitioning economy that has witnessed four-fold growth over the past decade, Kazakhstan's dynamically changing economic, social, educational and cultural environment provides incredible opportunities for significant and original research.

"The name Almaty has its roots in the medieval settlement Almatu, that existed near the present-day city. A disputed theory holds that the name is derived from the Kazakh word for 'apple' (алма), and is often translated as "full of apples"."

WHAT IS THE WEATHER/CLIMATE LIKE IN ALMATY?

"The climate in Almaty is a humid continental climate with hot summers and cold winters. It is characterized by the influence of mountain-valley circulation. "Annual average air temperature is equal to 10 °C (50 °F), the coldest month is January, -4.7 °C (24 °F) (on average), the warmest month (July) 23.8 °C (75 °F) (on average). Weather with temperature above 30 °C (86 °F) is average for about 36 days a year."

WHAT ARE THE TRANSPORTATION CONNECTIONS TO ALMATY?

The closest airport to Almaty is Almaty International Airport (identification code is ALA) located 15 kilometres (9.3 mi) to the northeast of the city center. Taxis and city buses connect the city with the airport. Almaty is served by two train stations that are connect with cities around Kazakhstan, Central Asia and Russia.

WHAT ARE MAIN OPTIONS FOR CHILDREN'S SCHOOLING?

Several options for elementary and secondary schools are: Almaty International School, Haileybury Almaty, Kazakhstan International School, Miras International School and Tien Shan International School.

WHAT IS THE COST OF LIVING IN ALMATY?

The cost of living (based on January 2019 figures) in Almaty is 74 percent lower than in New York City. Estimate of monthly living expenses for two people are \$660 for rent and additional \$600 for food expenses. According to the World Bank's price level ratio analysis, a dollar's worth of goods in the United States can be purchased for approximately 1/3 of a dollar in Kazakhstan.

WHAT ARE THE OPTIONS FOR HOUSING IN ALMATY?
